Instruction For Use - Beckman Coulter

Inspect centrifuge bottles and tubes or plates for cracks before use. Because a centrifuge can spin at such high speeds, a liquid sample can easily become an aerosol if it is not properly contained. Cracked tubes can fracture at high speeds or, at the very least, leak the sample into the rotor.

Centrifuge Safety - Eppendorf Handling Solutions

Fill centrifuge tubes, load into rotors, remove from rotors, and open tubes within a biological safety cabinet if biological safety cabinet is available. Wipe exterior of tubes or bottles with disinfectant prior to loading into rotor or bucket. Seal rotor or bucket, remove outer gloves, and transport to the centrifuge.

Centrifuge Safety - Laboratory Safety

Follow all operational specifications published in each rotor manual. Rotors must be used with the correct centrifuge (Beckman rotors in Beckman centrifuges). Proper rotor and centrifuge combinations will meet laboratory equipment standards and regulations of UL.
