To replace an engine mount you will need to raise the car up. Engine mounts are made of durable rubber which cushions the engine vibration from the vehicle frame. These mounts hold the engine in the car and are bolted to the engine block and then to the frame of the car.

How to Replace an Engine Mount in Under 1 hour

Replacing the front mount is a relatively simple operation, requiring no special tools, other than a few wrenches, socket set and a small jack for supporting and lifting the engine, along with a couple hours of relaxed shop time. Don't expect to find instructions for this job in the service manual.

Touring Model Front Motor Mount Replacement

A faulty mount can cause the engine to drop at one side, and excessive tilting can result in engine block and prevent you from using your car. If you notice any drooping in the engine, have the mounts inspected. The excessive engine movement caused by a broken motor mount can also cause problems with the belts and hoses in the engine.

1 Secure the vehicle so that it won't roll; and roll the spare tire to the scene of the action.. Detach the mount from the body frame and engine block. Apply a light coat of thread-locking compound to the bolts and install the new mount in place. Make sure you replace the bolts in their original location. You might need to use a pry bar to align the mounting holes in the body frame and engine block with those in the mount unit.

Route the drive cable around the right side of the engine and connect the zone control cable to the drive cable clip. Reconnect the zone control cable to the bail control bar. The front engine mount: Using a wrench and a ratchet (I believe these are 14mm.), remove the through bolt holding the engine mount to the radiator core support. This procedure is easier with the engine cooling fan removed. Unclip the lower radiator hose and coolant line from their retainers on the engine mount bracket.

Replacing engine mounts on Chrysler, Dodge, and Plymouth cars

With the scooter level and on frame block/jack, but with weight on the wheels, swing arm axle to front frame plate, equal on both sides. Lock the front mount down. Level the engine perpendicular to the floor and set the adjusters to no load.

The crankshaft damper and timing belt is removed. The crankshaft seal is removed and a new one installed. The timing belt and cover along with crankshaft damper is reinstalled. The engine accessory belts are installed and the vehicle is lowered off of the jack stands.
